

<u>Invitation to Participate in Research – Analysis of</u> Foreigners' Needs in Prague 11 City District

The Analysis of Foreigners' Needs in Prague 11 City District is carried out within the "Prague 11 City District Foreigner Integration" project which we've been implementing in Prague 11 for the fifth year straight.

The analysis is implemented by the Faculty of Science of Charles University. We expect the analysis to provide a deeper insight into the quality of the foreigners' life in our district and into how our district authorities could be more helpful towards them.
